RULES

I. <u>Eligibility</u>

- Farticipation is open to all students pursuing either an LL.B (3 years and 5 years) or an LL.M course in any University in India.
- Farticipation is restricted to a maximum of two authors per paper.
- Both the authors in case of co-authorship need not be pursuing their law degree from the same University.
- Only one paper can be submitted per author and in case of co-authorship, the author/s cannot submit a paper other than the one they have co-authored.

- The email should also contain name of the author/s and the name of the University/s.
- The last date for submitting articles is <u>31st October</u>, <u>2020</u>. No delays will be entertained.
