RULES

I. ELIGIBILITY

- *Participation is open to all students pursuing either an LL.B (3 years and 5 years) or an LL.M course in any University in India.*
- *Participation is restricted to a maximum of two authors per paper.*
- *Both the authors in case of co-authorship need not be pursuing their law degree from the same University.*
- *Only one paper can be submitted per author and in case of co-authorship, the author/s cannot submit a paper other than the one they have co-authored.*

- *The subject of the email should be 'Submission for Licitto Concurso '20'*
- *The email should also contain name of the author/s and the name of the University/s.*
- *The last date for submitting articles is 31st October, 2020. No delays will be entertained.*
- *Plagiarism will attract disqualification.*
